## ASSISTANT RIDE MANAGER I

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: Under the supervision of the Ride Manager I assists with the various supervisory duties in relation to the safe operation of an average sized, intricate amusement ride such as the Bumper Cars, during the summer operating season at Playland Amusement Park. This class is distinguished from the Assistant Ride Manager II by the amusement ride size and frequency of operation. The positions are seasonal in nature and exist only during the summer operating season at Playland Amusement Park. Supervision over a number of ride operators is a regular responsibility of this position. Does related work as required.

**EXAMPLES OF WORK:** (Illustrative Only)

Assists with the operation and procedures of an average size, intricate amusement ride;

Assists with maintaining strict safety and operation standards;

Provides customers with ride information and operating procedures;

Assures that all customers are treated courteously by Ride Operators and Attendants;

Inspects the grounds for cleanliness;

Assists with the inspection of ride according to safety checklist and notifies proper authority of any problems;

Assists with the supervision of the conduct and appearance of all Ride Operators;

Assists with the scheduling of all Ride Operators so that proper coverage is maintained.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND ATTRIBUTES: Comprehensive knowledge of the proper usage and safety factors of the particular ride or attraction; ability to understand and carry out oral and written instructions; ability to supervise and direct subordinates in routine operating procedures; pleasing personality; tact; courtesy; reliability; honesty; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

MINIMUM ACCEPTABLE TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE: There are no minimum qualifications.
