BATHHOUSE MANAGER - PLAYLAND

<u>DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:</u> Under general supervision, supervises the operation and maintenance of the bathing facilities Playland Amusement Park to ensure, clean and safe beach and pool. The incumbent is responsible for maintenance, repair, and public relations at these facilities. Limited exercise of independent judgment within the framework of established departmental policies is required in determining work methods and priority of projects. In addition, an employee in this position is available for other operating and maintenance functions at the park. Supervision is exercised over a substantial number of summer employees. There is no supervision in the off-season. Does related work as required.

EXAMPLES OF WORK: (Illustrative only)

Supervises the operation, maintenance and cleaning of all bathing facilities;

Handles complaints and requests for information from the general public;

Supervises the collection of monies at the bathhouse, beach and pool;

Operates the filtering and chlorinating equipment for the swimming pool, and cleans and makes minor repairs to the equipment;

Makes tests of pool water to insure conformity with State Health requirements;

Programs for and requisitions equipment and supplies, recommends maintenance projects and budget;

Assists in establishing safety precautions used at the bathing facilities, making reports and maintaining records as required.

Uses computer applications or other automated systems such as spreadsheets, word processing, calendar, e-mail and database software;

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES, AND ATTRIBUTES: Good knowledge of the practices and equipment used for operation and maintenance of a swimming pool, bathhouse, and beach; ability to plan, lay out and supervise the work of others; ability to maintain filtering and chlorinating equipment; ability to deal with the public tactfully and effectively; ability to effectively use computer applications or other automated systems such as spreadsheets, word processing, calendar, e-mail and database software; initiative; good judgment; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

MINIMUM ACCEPTABLE TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE: High School or equivalency diploma and either; (a) six years experience in which the primary function of the position was the operation and maintenance of bathing facilities which include a swimming pool; or (b) a Bachelor's Degree* and two years experience as stated in (a), above.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT: Possession of a pool operator's certificate.

<u>NOTE</u>: Unless otherwise noted, only experience gained after attaining the minimum education level indicated in the minimum qualifications will be considered in evaluating experience.

<u>*SPECIAL NOTE:</u> Education beyond the secondary must be from an institution recognized or accredited by the Board of Regents of the New York State Education Department as a post-secondary, degree-granting institution.
